Dear Officer Letter,

On September 22, 2005 at approximately 5 pm I was biking home from work eastbound on Hawthorne in the bicycle lane crossing the intersection of SE Grand. Charles Kee Lee Jr. was northbound on Grand Ave. driving a 93 Dodge Caravan. At the intersection of Grand and Hawthorne he proceeded through the red light at approximately 35-40 mph first colliding with myself, then Stacy Hearst Hall who was also eastbound on Hawthorne driving an 88 Cutlass.

Charles Lee was never cited for running the red light or for injuring a pedestrian/bicyclist even though there were 7 witnesses that Officer Letter spoke to who said that Charles Lee ran the red light, which resulted in the crash.

I, Michael J. Rueter, wish to use the citizen initiation law to bring charges against Charles Kee Lee Jr. for his actions of running a red light causing a crash, which hospitalized myself, resulting in approximately \$14,000 in medical bills and totaled Stacy Hearst Hall's vehicle.
